NOTING the "Decision on the evidence and information provided by the

Prosecution for the issuance of an arrest warrant against Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui"2

issued by the Chamber on 6 July 2007;

NOTING the arrest and surrender of Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui to the officials of the

Court and transfer to the Detention Centre of the Court in The Hague on 7 February

2008;3

NOTING the application entitled "Demande de mise en liberté provisoire" filed by the

Defence for Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui on 13 February 2008;

NOTING the "Decision on the Application for Interim Release of Mathieu Ngudjolo

Chui"<sup>5</sup> issued by the Single Judge on 27 March 2008, whereby the Single Judge found

that Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui shall remain in pre-trial detention because the

alternative conditions set forth in article 58(l)(b)(i) and (ii) of the Statute continue to

be fulfilled insofar as the detention of Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui remains necessary to

ensure (i) his appearance at trial; and (ii) that he will not obstruct or endanger the

investigation or the court proceedings;

NOTING the "Judgment In the Appeal by Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui of 27 March 2008

against the Decision of Pre-Trial Chamber I on the Application of the Appellant for

Interim Release" rendered by the Appeals Chamber on 9 June 2008, in which the

Appeals Chamber has upheld the decision of the Single Judge of 27 March 2008;

NOTING articles 58, 60(4), 61 and 67 of the Rome Statute ("the Statute"), rule 118 of

the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules") and regulation 24 of the Regulations

of the Court ("the Regulations");

**CONSIDERING** that according to rule 118 of the Rules, pre-trial detention must be

reviewed by the Pre-Trial Chamber at least every 120 days; and that Mathieu

Ngudjolo Chui would have been detained for 120 days on 25 July 2008;

CONSIDERING further that as the Single Judge has already stated "the Prosecution

has the burden of proof in relation to the continuing existence of the conditions set

forth in article 58(1) of the Statute during the time a person is under pre-trial

detention"7

FOR THESE REASONS

**DECIDE** to give:

(i) the Prosecution and the Legal Representatives of Anonymous

and of Non-Anonymous Victims until 2 July 2008 at 16h00 to

submit their observations on the pre-trial detention of Mathieu

Ngudjolo Chui at the seat of the Court;
