**PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER III** (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court (the "Court"), having been assigned with the situation in the Central African Republic, from which emanates the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* (the "Case"), considers the proper organisation of the related proceedings with regard to victims' issues.

- 1. On 3 October 2008, 24 applications for participation in the Case have been submitted to the Chamber by the Registrar.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. Pursuant to article 39(2)(b)(iii) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute"), the functions of the Pre-Trial Chamber shall be carried out either by three judges of the Pre-Trial Division or by a single judge of that division in accordance with the Statute and the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules").
- 3. Pursuant to article 57(2)(b) of the Statute, in all cases other than those listed in article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, a single judge of the Pre-Trial Chamber may exercise the functions provided for in the Statute, unless otherwise provided for in the Rules or by a majority of the Pre-Trial Chamber.
- 4. According to rule 7(1) of the Rules and regulation 47(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the designation of a single judge shall be based on objective pre-established criteria agreed upon by the Pre-Trial Chamber, including considerations of the issues involved, the circumstances of the proceedings before the Chamber, the distribution of work within the Chamber and the proper management and efficiency in the handling of cases.

The Chamber considers that in light of the abovementioned criteria, in particular the specificity and nature of the issues involved and the upcoming confirmation hearing, the need to ensure proper management and efficiency in the handling of victims' issues, makes it appropriate to designate Judge Hans-Peter Kaul as single judge responsible for all victims' issues in relation to the Case.

### FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

designates Judge Hans-Peter Kaul as single judge of Pre-Trial Chamber III, responsible for all victims' issues in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo*.
