**PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II** (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court, having been assigned with the situation of Uganda,<sup>1</sup> is considering the proper organisation of the proceedings before it in the upcoming period.

1. Pursuant to article 39(2)(b)(iii) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute"), the functions of the Pre-Trial Chamber shall be carried out either by three judges of the Pre-Trial Division or by a single judge of that Division in accordance with the Statute and the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules").

2. Pursuant to article 57(2)(b) of the Statute, in all cases other than those listed in article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, a single judge of the Pre-Trial Chamber may exercise the functions provided for in the Statute, unless otherwise provided for in the Rules or by a majority of the Pre-Trial Chamber.

3. The Chamber recalls rule 7(1) of the Rules and regulation 47(1) of the Regulations of the Court which establish that the designation of a single judge shall be based on objective criteria agreed upon by the Pre-Trial Chamber, including consideration of the issues involved, the circumstances of the proceedings before the Chamber, the distribution of work within the Chamber and the proper management and efficiency in the handling of cases.

4. The Chamber considers that in light of the abovementioned criteria, in particular the new constitution of the Chamber, the assignment of two situations to the Chamber, the replacement of Judge Mauro Politi, whose term of office ended on 10 March 2009, with Judge Fumiko Saiga by decision of the Presidency dated 19 March 2009,<sup>2</sup> as well as the need to ensure proper management and efficiency in the handling of victims' issues in the proceedings before the Chamber, it is appropriate to designate Judge Hans-Peter Kaul as Single Judge responsible for victims' issues in

relation to the proceedings of the situation of Uganda and the case of *The Prosecutor v. Joseph Kony, Vincent Otti, Okot Odhiambo and Dominic Ongwen*.

## FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

- a) designates Judge Hans-Peter Kaul as Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II responsible for all victims' issues in relation to the situation of Uganda and the case of *The Prosecutor v. Joseph Kony, Vincent Otti, Okot Odhiambo and Dominic Ongwen* until decided otherwise;
- b) orders the Registrar to file this decision in the record of the situation of Uganda and of the case of *The Prosecutor v. Joseph Kony, Vincent Otti, Okot Odhiambo and Dominic Ongwen.*
