Judge Ekaterina Trendafilova, acting as Single Judge on behalf of Pre-Trial Chamber II of the International Criminal Court with respect to the situation of the Central African Republic and the case of The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, except for all victims' issues,¹ is seized of the "Prosecution's Request for Extension of Page Limit for the Third Amended Document Containing the Charges" (the "Prosecutor's Request") submitted on 23 March 2009.²

1. On 3 March 2009 Pre-Trial Chamber III issued the "Decision Adjourning the Hearing pursuant to Article 61(7)(c) (ii) of the Rome Statute" (the "Adjournment Decision") in which it requested the Prosecutor to "consider submitting (...) no later than 30 March 2009 an amended document containing the charges addressing article 28 of the Statute as possible mode of criminal liability (...)''.³

2. The Prosecutor requests an extension of page limit regarding an amended document containing the charges to be submitted in compliance with the Adjournment Decision and the relevant statutory provisions.

3. The Single Judge notes regulation 37(2) of the Regulations of the Court according to which "[t]he Chamber may, at the request of a participant, extend the page limit [of a document filed with the Registry] in exceptional circumstances".

4. The Single Judge is persuaded by the Prosecutor's submission that granting an extension of page limit will enable him to offer a clear and detailed analysis of the elements related to command and superior responsibility under article 28 of the Rome Statute, which in turn will assist the Defence to prepare adequately and effectively for its written response.

5. The Single Judge considers accordingly that the above reasons reveal the existence of exceptional circumstances which justify the Prosecutor's Request.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE

decides to grant the Prosecutor the requested extension of forty five (45) pages for the amended document containing the charges.
