Judge Sanji Mmasenono Monageng, acting as Single Judge on behalf of Pre-Trial Chamber I (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court (the "Court") with respect to victims' issues in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bahar Idriss Abu Garda*;¹

NOTING the "Decision on the Designation of a Single Judge on Victims' Issues and on the Deadline for the Filling of Applications for Participation" of 19 August 2009 whereby the Chamber, *inter alia*, ordered the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the "VPRS") to submit, no later than Friday 11 September 2009, its report together with the victims' applications to be authorised to participate as victims in the proceedings relating to the confirmation of charges in the Abu Garda Case;²

NOTING the "Second report on applications to participate in the proceedings" filed by the Registry on 11 September 2009, ³ in which it submits, as annexes, 52 applications for participation in the pre-trial phase of the Case⁴ and a Letter form the Legal Representatives of Applicants a/0581/09 to a/0586/09;⁵

NOTING the "Report on applications a/0581/09 to a/0586/09 and request for extension of deadline in order to file supplementary information received" submitted by the VPRS on 15 September 2009; ⁶

NOTING the "Decision Ordering the Parties to Submit their Observations on the 52

NOTING the "Decision on the 52 Applications for Participation at the Pre-Trial

Stage of the Case" of 8 October 2009, whereby the Single Judge denied authorization

to participate in the proceedings as victims to Applicants a/0581/09 to a/0586/09 (the

"Applicants");9

NOTING the "Request in respect of Information relevant to Victim Participation on

the basis of the Decision on 52 Applications for Participation at the Pre-Trial Stage of

the Case" of 9 October 2009 ("The Legal Representatives' Request"), whereby the

Legal Representatives of the Applicants urged the Single Judge to consider further

information to be obtained from the Applicants and to be submitted to the VPRS by

Monday 12 October 2009;10

NOTING the "Filing of further supplementary information in relation to applications a/0582/09, a/0584/09 and a/0585/09" submitted by the VPRS on 13 October 2009;¹²

NOTING article 68(3) of the *Rome Statute* ("the Statute"), rule 89(2) of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence* ("the Rules") and regulations 34(a) and 35 of the *Regulations of the Court* ("the Regulations");

CONSIDERING that in the 16 September 2009 Decision the Single Judge granted the extension of time limit requested in relation to the Applicants until 16 September 2009 and recalled that "additional applications, at this stage of the proceedings, will not be accepted";¹³

CONSIDERING therefore that, being filed after the aforementioned 16 September 2009 deadline, the Legal Representatives' Request and the supplementary information will not be considered by the Single Judge, at this stage of the proceedings leading to and at the confirmation hearing in the present case, without prejudice for a further submission "later in the proceedings", pursuant to rule 89(2) of the Rules;
