**I, Judge Sylvia Steiner**, Presiding Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I ("the Chamber") at the International Criminal Court ("the Court");

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Prosecutor's requests for extension of time limit" of 11 September 2009, whereby the Single Judge decided, *inter alia*, to re-schedule the confirmation hearing to 19 October 2009;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the "Decision Distributing the Proposed Schedule for the Confirmation Hearing" of 2 October 2009 ("the 2 October 2009 Decision");<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the "Decision on victims' modalities of participation at the Pre-Trial Stage of the Case" issued by the Chamber on 6 October 2009 (the "Decision on victims' modalities of participation");<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Schedule for the Confirmation Hearing" of 13 October 2009 ("the 13 October 2009 Decision"), whereby the Presiding Judge, *inter alia*, anticipated the date of appearance of Prosecution witnesses;<sup>4</sup>

**NOTING** the "Observations of the Registry on the schedule of the Confirmation Hearing" ("The Registry's Observations") of 14 October 2009;<sup>5</sup>

**NOTING** the "Prosecutor's request for an order directing the Defence to remove its proposed viva voce witness from its list of witnesses" of 14 October 2009 (the "Prosecutor's Request");<sup>6</sup>

**NOTING** the "Response to 'Prosecution's request for an order directing the Defence to remove its proposed viva voce witness from its list of witnesses'" of 16 October 2009;<sup>7</sup>

**NOTING** the "1. Request in respect of Lifting of Anonymity of Victims 2. Request for Access to Documents Relating to Witnesses" of 16 October 2009;<sup>8</sup>

NOTING the "Decision lifting anonymity of victims" of 16 October 2009;9

NOTING articles 61, 67, 68 and 69 of the Statute of the Court, rules 63, 87, 91(3), 121, 122 and 140 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") and regulation 20 of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that in the Registry's Observations, the Registry stated that it "can not accommodate the scheduled appearance of witnesses as spelled out in the Decision of 13 October" and recommended that the dates for the appearance of witnesses provided for in the 2 October 2009 Decision be maintained in order to "ensure sufficient time for courtesy meeting, Courtroom familiarization, psychosocial assessment and statement reading";

**CONSIDERING** that, in accordance with rule 91(3) of the Rules and as established in the Decision on victims' modalities of participation, when the identities of victims are disclosed to the parties, "if any of the victims' legal representatives wish to question any of the witnesses called to testify at the confirmation hearing, they must make an application to the Chamber" and "the Chamber will decide, at that time, on the procedure that must be followed";<sup>10</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Presiding Judge deems it appropriate to amend the schedule for the confirmation hearing as established in the 13 October 2009 Decision in order to enable the Registry to ensure the appearance of the Prosecution witness and to allocate some time for the questioning of witnesses by the Legal Representatives of victims, where authorized by the Chamber;

**CONSIDERING** finally that the present decision is taken without prejudice to the decisions to be taken in due time and related to pending requests before the Chamber;
