NOTING the "Decision on the Confirmation of Charges" issued on 8 February 2010,² whereby the Chamber (i) declined to confirm the charges against Bahar Idriss Abu Garda and (ii) decided that "the five-day period for the parties for the parties to present an application for leave to appeal in accordance with rule 155(1) of the Rules shall start to run with effect from the date of notification of the Arabic translation of this Decision";

NOTING the "Defence Application for variation of time limit for filing of application for leave to appeal" filed on 25 February 2010,³ whereby the Defence requested the Chamber to vary the time limit for the filing of applications for leave to appeal, in accordance with regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court, by lifting the suspension of the commencement of the five-day period under rule 155(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

NOTING regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that, due to the nature of the relief sought by the Defence, it appears appropriate to invite the Prosecutor to respond to the Defence application on an expedited basis in order not to defeat the purpose of such application should it be granted;
