I, Judge Cuno Tarfusser, Single Judge responsible for carrying out the

functions of Pre-Trial Chamber I in relation to the proceedings of the situation

in Darfur, Sudan and any related cases emanating therefrom, including the

case of The Prosecutor v. Omar Hassan Ahmad Al Bashir, at the International

Criminal Court<sup>1</sup>;

NOTING the "Requête pour l'obtention d'une ordonnance condamnant les

déclarations du Procureur en date du 15 juillet 2010", dated 5 August 2010

(the "Request"),2 whereby Ms. Michelyne C. St-Laurent brought to the

Chamber's attention an article authored by the Prosecutor that appeared in

the newspaper "The Guardian" following the issuance of an arrest warrant

for Omar Al Bashir for the crime of genocide, questioning the propriety of the

statements contained in the article and requesting the Chamber to take all the

measures deemed appropriate;

NOTING that Ms. St-Laurent brings her filing as the ad-hoc defence Counsel

for Omar Al-Bashir;

NOTING that Ms. St-Laurent has been entrusted by the Chamber, in

accordance with regulation 76(1) of the Regulations of the Court, with the task

of representing and protecting the interests of the defence only within the

context and for the purposes of the proceedings related to victims'

applications for participation;<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** that the Request filed before the Chamber does not relate to any

such proceedings;
