Trial Chamber III ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court in the case of The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo issues the following Decision requesting observations on, and setting a briefing schedule for, the "Demande de mise en liberté provisoire de M. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo afin d'accomplir ses devoirs civiques en République Démocratique du Congo".

- 1. On 24 August 2011, the defence filed its "Demande de mise en liberté provisoire de M. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo afin d'accomplir ses devoirs civiques en République Démocratique du Congo" ("Request for Provisional Release"), 1 requesting the Chamber to authorize the provisional release of Mr Bemba to travel to the Democratic Republic of the Congo before 5 September 2011 to obtain a voting card and to file his candidacy for the upcoming presidential and parliamentary elections.²
- 2. The defence seeks a ruling on the Request for Provisional Release before the end of August and requests a shortened briefing schedule to accommodate that timeframe.3
- 3. In accordance with Article 21(1) of the Rome Statute ("Statute"), the Chamber has considered Article 64(6)(f) of the Statute, Rule 118 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulations 24, 34 and 35 of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations").
- 4. Under Regulation 35 of the Regulations, a Chamber "may extend or reduce a time limit if good cause is shown". It appears that the Request for Provisional Release would become moot if the Chamber ruled only after receiving submissions under the time limits prescribed in Regulation 34 of

the Regulations. This constitutes good cause for a reduction of the usual time limits.

- 5. Although the Chamber is not required in the present circumstances to seek the views of victim applicants whose applications for participation in the proceedings have not yet been ruled upon, it may nevertheless benefit from receiving observations from the Office of Public Counsel for Victims ("OPCV"). For this reason, the Chamber, in an exercise of its discretion under Article 64(6)(f) of the Statute, will permit the OPCV to file observations on the Request for Provisional Release if it so wishes, on behalf of those victim applicants whose applications have not yet been ruled upon.
- 6. For these reasons, the Trial Chamber hereby ORDERS that:
- (a) The prosecution, legal representatives of victims and the OPCV shall submit their observations on the Request for Provisional Release no later than 16.00 on Monday, 29 August 2011;
- (b) The defence shall submit its reply, if any, to the observations of the prosecution, legal representatives of victims and the OPCV no later than 10.00 on Tuesday, 30 August 2011.
