Trial Chamber IV ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court ("Court") in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Abdallah Banda Abakaer Nourain and Saleh Mohammed Jerbo Jamus*, in accordance with Articles 64(2) and 68(3) of the Rome Statute and Rules 16(1)(b) and 90 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), issues the following Order inviting the Registrar to appoint a common legal representative.

- 1. On 15 April 2011, the Registry filed its "Report recommending a decision concerning the common legal representation of victims participating in the case".
- 2. On 21 April 2011, the Chamber issued its "Order instructing the Registry to start consultations on the organisation of common legal representation", <sup>2</sup> in which it, *inter alia*, ordered the Registry to consult with the 89 participating victims with a view to appointing a common legal representative or common legal representatives representing their interests for the remainder of the proceedings in this case, in the presence of their current legal representatives.<sup>3</sup>
- 3. On 25 August 2011, upon instruction by the Chamber, 4 the Registry filed its "Proposal for the common legal representation of victims" ("Proposal") together with annexes, 5 which was notified on 26 August 2011. On this latter date, the
