

Trial Chamber III ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court ("Court"), in the case of The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo issues the following Decision on the "Defence request for an *ex parte* status conference".

- 1. On 8 May 2012, the defence filed the "Defence request for an ex parte status conference" ("Request"),1 in order to discuss issues related to the defence's presentation of evidence.
- 2. Having considered the Request, the Chamber agrees to the holding of an ex parte status conference, to address the issues raised by the defence
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 132(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Chamber hereby ORDERS that:
 - (a) An ex parte status conference in this case will be held at 09.30 on 10 May 2012;
 - (b) The status conference will be held in closed session;
 - (c) The attendees of the status conference will be the defence, the Registry and representatives of the Victims and Witnesses Unit;

The present decision is filed as public, in accordance with article 64(7) of the Rome Statute, and since the Chamber is of the view that, in principle, there is no reason for the scheduling of an ex parte a status conference not to be disclosed to the prosecution, the Legal Representatives of Victims and the public.
