Trial Chamber V ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court in the case of The

Prosecutor v. Francis Kirimi Muthaura and Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta renders the following

Decision on the "Joint Prosecution/ Kenyatta Defence Application Pursuant to Regulation

35 of the Regulations of the Court".

1. On 5 July 2012, the Chamber ordered the Prosecutor ("prosecution") first to provide

the defence with a draft of an updated Document Containing the Charges ("DCC")

by 6 August and, following inter partes consultations on this draft, thereafter to

submit the updated DCC to the Chamber by 21 August 2012.1

2. On 21 August 2012, the prosecution and the Kenyatta defence team filed the "Joint

Prosecution/ Kenyatta Defence Application Pursuant to Regulation 35 of the

Regulations of the Court" ("Request").2 In the Request, the prosecution and the

Kenyatta defence team: (i) inform the Chamber that, as a result of their inter partes

consultations, the parties may be able to reach an agreement on a number of issues

that the defence teams have raised in their observations on the draft of the updated

DCC,3 (ii) allege that, due to the volume, nature and complexity of the disputed

issues, the current 21 August 2012 deadline provides insufficient time for the parties

to conclude their discussions<sup>4</sup> and, (iii) accordingly, request that the Chamber extend

the time limit for filing the updated DCC to 24 August 2012.<sup>5</sup>

3. The prosecution and the Kenyatta defence submit that "the requested extension is in

the interests of justice and would expedite the proceedings because it would a)

increase the chances of the parties reaching agreement on the disputed issues,

thereby reducing the need for the intervention of the Chamber and rendering the

proceedings more efficient, and b) allow all the parties to fully elaborate their respective positions on the legal and factual issues at stake, thereby assisting the Chamber in reaching its decision on any areas that remain in dispute."<sup>6</sup>

4. Pursuant to Regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court and in light of the reasons submitted by the prosecution and the Kenyatta defence team, the Chamber is satisfied that good cause is shown for granting the requested extension of time.

# FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

**GRANTS** the relief sought in the Request, thereby permitting that the updated DCC, along with any jointly submitted annex raising the parties' points of disagreement with the updated DCC's language, may be filed by 24 August 2012.
