Trial Chamber V(A) (the 'Chamber') of the International Criminal Court (the 'Court'), in

the case of The Prosecutor v. William Samoei Ruto and Joshua Arap Sang, having regard to

Articles 64(3)(c) and 68(1) of the Rome Statute (the 'Statute'), Rule 81 of the Rules of

Procedure and Evidence (the 'Rules') and Regulation 23bis of the Regulations of the Court

(the 'Regulations'), issues this Order authorising disclosure of victims' applications.

1. On 5 September 2013, the Legal Representative of Victims (the 'LRV') filed the

'Notification of Dual Status Victims in Prosecution's updated list of witnesses'

(the 'LRV Notification).1

2. The LRV informs the Chamber that in light of the 'Prosecution's updated witness

list and witness summaries' filed on 2 September 2013,2 the LRV has found that

some of the witnesses are qualified as victims of the case and have filled-in an

application form.3

3. The LRV further submits that, to the best of his knowledge, the status of four of

these individuals has not been notified to any party and their application forms

have not been disclosed.4

4. The Chamber notes that on 24 July 2013, it authorised disclosure of victims'

applications of five Prosecution witnesses. However, the Chamber authorised that

limited redactions be kept vis-à-vis the defence, specifically redactions to the

contact information of witnesses and other third parties.<sup>5</sup>

5. The Chamber considers that the authorisation of Chamber mentioned above

applies mutatis mutandis to the LRV Notification. Consequently, the LRV shall

transmit to the parties the applications forms of the five dual status victims

identified in the LRV Notification. Nevertheless, pursuant to Article 68(1) of the Statute and Rule 81(4) of the Rules, redactions to the contact information of witnesses and other third parties shall be maintained vis-à-vis the defence.

6. Moreover, considering that the LRV Notification was filed confidential *ex parte* awaiting the Chamber's instructions, <sup>6</sup> and pursuant to Regulation 23bis, the Chamber orders that the LRV Notification is reclassified as Confidential.

## FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

**DIRECTS** the LRV to transmit to the parties the applications forms of the five dual status victims identified in the LRV Notification, albeit maintaining redactions to the contact information of witnesses and other third parties vis-à-vis the defence.

**ORDERS** the reclassification of filing ICC-01/09-01/11-908-Conf-Exp as Confidential.
