**Trial Chamber V(B)** ('Chamber') of the International Criminal Court in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta*, pursuant to Article 64(2) and (6) of the Rome Statute, Rules 101(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulation 34 of the Regulations of the Court, issues the following 'Order requiring a notice in relation to the provisional trial commencement date'.

1. On 31 March 2014, in its 'Decision on Prosecution's applications for a finding of non-compliance pursuant to Article 87(7) and for adjournment of the provisional trial date',<sup>1</sup> the Chamber, *inter alia*, adjourned the provisional trial commencement date to 7 October 2014<sup>2</sup> to allow further time for the resolution of certain cooperation issues between the Government of the Republic of Kenya and the Office of the Prosecutor ('Prosecution').
2. Noting the importance of timely and efficient preparations and in order to provide the necessary guidance for parties and participants, the Chamber orders the Prosecution to file a notice confirming whether it anticipates being in a position to start trial on the provisionally scheduled commencement date of 7 October 2014 ('Notice').

**FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY**

**ORDERS** the Prosecution to file the Notice by 5 September 2014; and


**ORDERS** the defence team for Mr Kenyatta and the Legal Representative of Victims to file responses thereto, if any, by 10 September 2014.


