1. Pursuant to Article 64(2) of the Rome Statute and Rule 132(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, Trial Chamber III of the International Criminal Court in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* hereby ORDERS that:

a) A status conference in this case will be held at 09.30 on Tuesday, 23 September 2014, to hear submissions concerning documents ICC-01/05-01/08-3138-Conf-Red and ICC-01/05-01/08-3139-Conf and related filings;


b) As the issues to be discussed will include matters of witness protection, the status conference will be held in closed session;

c) The attendees at the status conference shall be the Office of the Prosecutor (“prosecution”), the defence for Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo (“defence”), the legal representative of victims and representatives of the Registry, including the Victims and Witnesses Unit.


2. Pending a decision on the matters raised in documents ICC-01/05-01/08-3138-Conf-Red and ICC-01/05-01/08-3139-Conf, the Chamber rejects the defence’s request for suspension of the time-frame for the filing of the defence’s reply to the prosecution’s and legal representative’s responses to the defence’s closing brief, and the closing arguments.¹
