Trial Chamber III ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court ("Court"), in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* ("*Bemba* case"), issues the following Notice of limited reopening of the presentation of evidence and rescheduling of closing statements.

- 1. On 16 July 2013, the Chamber issued its "Decision on the timeline for the completion of the defence's presentation of evidence and issues related to the closing of the case",¹ in which it established a schedule and gave directions for the filing of closing briefs and the presentation of final oral submissions.² In this context, the Chamber decided that the final oral submissions would be presented "two weeks after the filing of the defence's reply".³
- 2. On 7 April 2014, the Chamber issued its "Decision on closure of evidence and other procedural matters",⁴ in which it, *inter alia*, declared the submission of evidence closed pursuant to Rule 141(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.⁵
- 3. On 26 May 2014, the Chamber issued its "Decision on the timetable and on the sentencing procedure", ⁶ in which it, *inter alia*, (i) ordered the defence for Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba ("defence") to file its closing brief by 25 August 2014; (ii) ordered the Office of the Prosecutor ("prosecution") and the legal representative of victims, Maître Marie-Edith Douzima-Lawson, to file any responses to the defence's closing brief by 8 September 2014; (iii) ordered the defence the defence to file its reply to the responses by 22 September 2014; and (iv) decided that the final oral submissions would be heard as of 13 October 2014,

unless otherwise decided.⁷

- 4. On 4 September 2014, pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute ("Statute"), the prosecution disclosed to the defence a confidential document related to Witness P-169 ("Disclosed Document").⁸
- On 11 September 2014, the prosecution filed its "Prosecution's Information to Trial Chamber III on issues involving witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0169" ("ICC-01/05-01/08-3138-Conf-Red").⁹ On the same day, the defence filed its "Defence Urgent Submission on the [Disclosed Document]" ("ICC-01/05-01/08-3139-Conf").¹⁰
- 6. On 23 September 2014, the Chamber convened a status conference to hear submissions concerning ICC-01/05-01/08-3138-Conf-Red ¹¹ and ICC-01/05-01/08-3139-Conf¹² and related filings.¹³ In this context, the Chamber denied the defence's request to suspend the timeframe for the filing of the defence's reply brief.¹⁴
- 7. On 29 September 2014, the defence filed "Mr. Bemba's Reply Brief".¹⁵

- On 2 October 2014, the Chamber issued its confidential "Decision on 'Prosecution's Information to Trial Chamber III on issues involving witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0169' (ICC-01/05-01/08-3138-Conf-Red) and 'Defence Urgent Submissions on the [Disclosed Document]' (ICC-01/05-01/08-3139-Conf)" ("Decision 3154").¹⁶
- 9. In light of the principle of publicity under Articles 64(7) and 67(1) of the Statute and Regulation 20 of the Regulations of the Court, the Chamber hereby provides public notice that in Decision 3154 the Chamber decided:
 - to reopen the presentation of evidence in the *Bemba* case for the limited purpose of hearing Witness P-169 on issues related to the allegations contained in the Disclosed Document, including issues of witness credibility;
 - (ii) that Witness P-169 shall be heard at the seat of the Court as of 14
 October 2014;
 - (iii) that following Witness P-169's testimony, the prosecution and the legal representative shall have seven days, and the defence shall have 14 days to file additional submissions to their closing briefs. These additional submissions shall relate exclusively to Witness P-169's testimony and any related evidence admitted by the Chamber; and
 - (iv) that the final oral submissions shall be presented during the week of 10 November 2014, unless otherwise decided.
