Trial Chamber V(A) (the 'Chamber') of the International Criminal Court, in the case of

The Prosecutor v William Samoei Ruto and Joshua Arap Sang, pursuant to Articles 64(9)(a)

and 69(4) of the Rome Statute, renders this 'Decision on the Ruto Defence Request for

Materials Related to Witness 743 to be Accepted into Evidence and Assigned Evidence

(EVD) Numbers'.

1. On 29 January 2015, during the testimony of Witness 743, the Presiding Judge

indicated that four Victims and Witnesses Unit (the 'VWU') documents related to

Witness 743 should be put in the record. Accordingly, and given that the

documents were not yet uploaded in the E-court system at the time of the

testimony, the defence for Mr Ruto (the 'Ruto Defence') proposed that their

admission be requested by way of written filing. The Presiding Judge endorsed this

procedure.1

2. On 2 February 2015, the Ruto Defence requested the admission of the aforesaid

VWU documents, as confidential exhibits in the case (the 'Request').2 Accordingly,

it requested that the following exhibits be assigned evidence (EVD) numbers: (i)

KEN-D09-0045-0435_R01; (ii) KEN-D09-0045-0437_R01; (iii) KEN-D09-0045-

0439_R01; and (iv) KEN-D09-0045-0442_R01.

3. On that same date, the Prosecution and the defence team for Mr Sang (the 'Sang

Defence') confirmed via email that they have no objections to the Ruto Defence

Request.3

4. The Chamber notes that the four VWU documents were used during the

examination of Witness 743 and that the Presiding Judge indicated during the

testimony of this witness that these should be put in the record of the case.4

DIRECTS the Registry to confirm these numbers have been assigned via a written filing no later than 13 February 2015.
