NOTING the Chamber's "Order to the Registrar and the Prosecutor for the

submission of information on the reported movement of persons whose arrest is

sought" dated 28 February 20071;

NOTING the Prosecutor's "Submission of information on the reported movement of

persons whose arrest has been sought" dated 7 March 20073, in which the Prosecutor

submitted that "in the factual circumstances presented, it would avoid any potential

ambiguity about cooperation obligation, and thus serve the letter and spirit of Article

89(1), were the Chamber to order the transmission of requests for cooperation to the

Central African Republic before any person whose arrest is sought is confirmed to

have located himself in the Central African Republic.";

CONSIDERING the need for the Chamber to receive additional information on the

location of persons whose arrest is sought in order to exercise its powers and fulfill

its duties, in particular under Part 9 of the Statute, and to assess the need to take

further steps for the execution of the Warrants;

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NOTING article 87, paragraph 3 of the Statute;

CONSIDERING the need to preserve confidentiality in submissions concerning movements of persons whose arrest is sought, in order to support arrest efforts;

HAVING REGARD THERETO AND FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

REQUESTS the Prosecutor to provide, on or before Monday 26 March 2007, information concerning the possible movement of persons whose arrest has been sought to Chad, in order to allow the Chamber to assess the need to take further steps regarding the execution of the Warrants.
