TRIAL CHAMBER II ("the Chamber") of the International Criminal Court, acting pursuant to article 85 of the Rome Statute ("the Statute") and rule 174(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules"), orders the following.

1. On 27 February 2015, the Appeals Chamber rendered its judgment confirming, by majority, the decision of Trial Chamber II dated 18 December 2012 acquitting Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui.¹

2. On 14 August 2015, Counsel for Mr Ngudjolo filed a request for compensation on the grounds of article 85 of the Statute² ("the Request for Compensation").

3. The Chamber notes that rule 174(1) of the Rules provides that "[a] request for compensation [...] shall be transmitted to the Prosecutor, who shall have an opportunity to respond in writing."
