Judge' and 'Chamber', respectively) of the International Criminal Court ('Court'), issues the following 'Decision on Prosecution's Request to Issue a Public Redacted Version of Decision ICC-01/05-01/13-1234-Conf', in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo, Fidèle Babala Wandu and Narcisse Arido*, having regard to Articles 64(7) and 67(1) of the Rome Statute ('Statute') and Regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court.

- On 10 September 2015, the Single Judge confidentially issued the 'Decision on Defence Requests for Prosecution Requests for Assistance, Domestic Records and Audio Recordings of Interviews' ('Decision').¹
- 2. On 24 June 2016, the Prosecution filed a request that the Chamber issue a public redacted version of the Decision ('Request'). The Prosecution also indicates that the approach of the Decision, with other confidential case-law, may recently have assumed new significance for the interpretation of the Statute and Rules of Procedure and Evidence with respect to disclosure of requests for assistance or similar materials under Rule 77.²
- 3. By 28 June 2016,³ none of the defence teams responded to the Request.
- 4. There is a general interest in the publicity of this Court's proceedings, and the Single Judge agrees that the Decision no longer needs to remain confidential. The Single Judge considers that reclassification of the Decision is more appropriate than issuing a redacted version, since the countries of interest proposed for redaction by the Prosecution have already been publicly identified

in other contexts.⁴ The Single Judge therefore grants the Request in part and orders reclassification of the Decision.

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE HEREBY

ORDERS the Registry to reclassify the Decision (ICC-01/05-01/13-1234-Conf), the Request (ICC-01/05-01/13-1937-Conf) and its annex ('ICC-01/05-01/13-1937-Conf-AnxA') as 'public'.
