**Judge Raul C. Pangalangan**, acting as Single Judge on behalf of Trial Chamber VIII ('Single Judge' and 'Chamber', respectively) of the International Criminal Court issues the following 'Decision on LRV Request for Resumption of Action for Deceased Victim a/35084/16', in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi*, having regard to Article 68(3) of the Rome Statute and Regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court.

1. On 29 September 2016, the Chamber issued the Reparations Phase Calendar, setting the deadline for any applications for reparations on 16 December 2016.<sup>1</sup>
2. On 11 May 2017, the Legal Representative of the Victims ('LRV') filed a request announcing the death of reparations applicant a/35084/16 and requesting that her daughter succeed her for purposes of the application ('Request').<sup>2</sup> The LRV provides supporting materials to establish that: (i) a/35084/16 died; (ii) the person proposed as a successor is a/35084/16's daughter and (iii) a/35084/16's family wants this person to resume the action initiated by a/35084/16 before the Court.<sup>3</sup>
3. On 26 May 2017,<sup>4</sup> the Defence indicated that it did not oppose the request and that it would rely on the judges to assess the validity of the supporting documents.<sup>5</sup>
4. Observing that the Defence did not oppose the request, and given the reasons and supporting materials put forward by the LRV, the Single Judge considers that the Request can be granted.


