
1. The Chamber hereby schedules a status conference for 8 December 2017, to address issues relating to the timeline for the conclusion of the presentation of evidence.
2. To facilitate the preparation of the parties and the participants, the Chamber sets the following agenda:
 - a) timeline for the completion of the Defence's presentation of evidence;
 - b) potential presentation of further evidence following the conclusion of the Defence's presentation of evidence (including rebuttal evidence, if any, and/or witnesses called by the Chamber);
 - c) timeline for the submission of closing briefs and the presentation of the oral closing statements, and their respective expected length; and
 - d) any other items.
3. Should the parties and the participants, or the Registry wish to raise any particular issues under agenda item d), they shall inform the Chamber, copying all parties and participants, via email by 1 December 2017, at 16:00.

SCHEDULES a status conference for 8 December 2017 at 09:30; and

SETS the agenda for the status conference, as provided in paragraph 2 above.
