PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court (the "Court") issues this decision designating a Single Judge.

1. On 30 May 2014, the Government of the Central African Republic (the "CAR") referred the situation in the CAR since 1 August 2012 to the Court (the "Situation").¹

2. The Chamber notes articles 39(2)(b)(iii) and 57(2)(b) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute"), rule 7(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulation 47(1) of the Regulations of the Court.

3. In light of the criteria contained in the aforementioned provisions, and in particular the need to ensure the proper management, expeditiousness, and efficiency of the proceedings, the Chamber considers it appropriate to designate Judge Tomoko Akane as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, in the Situation and any case emanating therefrom for the period from 12 November 2018 to 22 November 2018 (inclusive).
