PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court (the "Court") issues this decision designating a Single Judge.

- 1. On 30 May 2014, the Government of the Central African Republic (the "CAR") referred the situation in the CAR since 1 August 2012 to the Court.¹
- 2. On 18 June 2014, this situation was assigned to the Chamber.²
- 3. On 11 November 2018, the Chamber issued a warrant of arrest against Alfred Yekatom,³ who was surrendered to the Court on 17 November 2018.
- 4. The Chamber notes articles 39(2)(b)(iii) and 57(2)(b) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute"), rule 7(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 47(1) of the Regulations of the Court.
- 5. In light of the criteria contained in the aforementioned provisions and, in particular, the need to ensure the proper management, expeditiousness and efficiency of the proceedings, the Chamber considers it appropriate to designate Judge Tomoko Akane as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber in the present case, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, for the period 14 December 2018 to 23 December 2018 (inclusive).
- 6. For the same reasons, the Chamber considers it appropriate to further designate Judge Rosario Salvatore Aitala as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber in the present case, subject to

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

DESIGNATES Judge Tomoko Akane as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Alfred Yekatom* for the period 14 December 2018 to 23 December 2018 (inclusive); and

DESIGNATES Judge Rosario Salvatore Aitala as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Alfred Yekatom* for the period 24 December 2018 to 23 January 2019 (inclusive).
