The Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Court,

In the appeal of the Prosecutor against the oral decision of Trial Chamber I pursuant to article 81(3)(c)(i) of the Statute of 16 January 2019 (ICC-02/11-01/15-T-234-Eng),

Having before it the 'Prosecution's Appeal pursuant to article 81(3)(c)(ii) of the Statute and urgent request for suspensive effect' of 16 January 2019 (ICC-02/11-01/15-1236), in which a request for suspensive effect is made,

Issues the following

ORDER

1. Mr Laurent Gbagbo, Mr Charles Blé Goudé and the victims participating in the proceedings may file their respective responses to the above-mentioned request for suspensive effect by 12h00 on 17 January 2019.
2. Pursuant to article 83(1), read with article 64(6)(f) of the Statute, Mr Laurent Gbagbo and Mr Charles Blé Goudé shall be detained pending the Appeals Chamber's decision on the Prosecutor's request for suspensive effect.
