

**Trial Chamber VI** of the International Criminal Court (the ‘Chamber’), in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bosco Ntaganda* (the ‘Ntaganda case’), having regard to Rule 132 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the ‘Rules’), issues this ‘Decision notifying the designation of a Single Judge’.

1. On 18 July 2014, the Presidency constituted the Chamber, composed of Judge Kuniko Ozaki, Judge Robert Fremr and Judge Geoffrey Henderson, and referred the *Ntaganda* case to it.<sup>1</sup> On 21 July 2014, the judges of the Chamber elected Judge Robert Fremr as Presiding Judge.<sup>2</sup>
2. On 18 March 2015, the Presidency re-composed the Chamber to be comprised of Judge Kuniko Ozaki, Judge Robert Fremr and Judge Chang-ho Chung.<sup>3</sup> On 19 March 2015, the judges of the Chamber, in its new composition, elected Judge Robert Fremr as the Presiding Judge.<sup>4</sup>
3. Pursuant to Rule 132 *bis* of the Rules, the Chamber **DESIGNATES** Judge Chang-ho Chung as Single Judge for the purpose of the reparations phase of proceedings.
