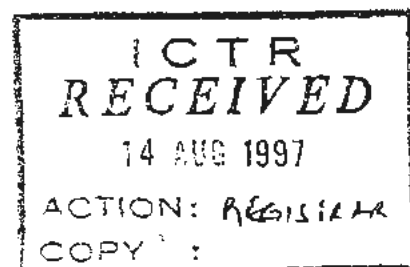


HAVING BEEN SEIZED by the Prosecutor's requests of 12 August 1997 pursuant to Rule 40bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") seeking extension of the provisional detention of Jean Kambanda (Case No. ICTR-97-23-DP), Hassan Ngeze (Case No. ICTR-97-27-DP), Sylvain Nsabimana (Case No. ICTR-97-29-DP), Aloys Ntabakuze (Case No. ICTR-97-30-DP), Georges O. Ruggiu (Case No. ICTR-97-32-DP), and Gratién Kabiligi (Case No. ICTR-97-34-DP);

CONSIDERING the pleas submitted by members of the press for authorization to photograph and videotape an open session of the Tribunal;

PURSUANT TO article 81 (D) of the Rules;

AUTHORISES the taking of photographs and video-recording in the court-room by duly assigned members of the press during all open hearings in the cases mentioned above subject to other decisions, notably those pertaining to the protection of witnesses, which may be taken by the Tribunal's Trial Chamber at a later stage.
