THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA (the "TRIBUNAL"),

SITTING as Trial Chamber I, composed of Judge Laïty Kama, Presiding Judge, Judge Lennart Aspegren and Judge Navanethem Pillay;

CONSIDERING the indictment against the accused Jean Kambanda submitted by the Prosecutor on 15 October 1997 and confirmed on 16 October 1997 by Judge Yakov Ostrovsky (Case No. ICTR-97-23-T);

CONSIDERING the initial appearance of the above-mentioned accused on 1 May 1998 before the Tribunal;

WHEREAS, during the initial appearance, the accused pleaded guilty to all counts in the indictment (genocide, conspiracy to commit genocide, direct and public incitement to commit genocide, complicity in genocide, crimes against humanity), punishable pursuant to articles 22 and 23 of the Statute of the Tribunal;

WHEREAS, pursuant to his guilty plea, the Tribunal decides that Jean Kambanda shall remain in detention until otherwise decided by the Tribunal;

THE TRIBUNAL

DECIDES to order the continued detention of Jean Kambanda until otherwise decided by the Tribunal;
