

1. In accordance with Rule 53(C) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence a Judge, on duty pursuant to Rule 28, should consult the Prosecutor with regard to disclosure orders pertaining to the indictment or any particular document or information.
2. Taking into account that the indictment and supporting materials in question were submitted to the confirming judge at the last moment prior to the expiration of the accused's provisional detention, the necessary consultations with the Prosecutor could take place only after the signing of the Decision on the Review of the Indictment.
3. Considering that during consultations the Prosecutor requested to amend the final paragraph of the abovementioned decision, this paragraph should now read as follows:

"ORDERS, after consultation with the Prosecutor, that there be no public disclosure of the indictment pursuant to Rule 53(B) of the Rules until the indictment has been served on the accused."
