NOTING the pending appeals filed by Jean-Paul AKAYESU (the "Appellant") and by the Prosecutor against the Judgement of Trial Chamber II delivered on 2 September 1998 and the Sentence delivered on 2 October 1998;

NOTING that the Appellant filed his last brief in his appeal on 19 September 2000, and that the Prosecutor filed her last brief in her appeal on 19 September 2000;

NOTING that pursuant to Rule 117bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, each party should prepare and file eight copies of an Appeal Book and eight copies of a Book of Authorities, in the format specified in this Rule, within seven days following the filing of the last brief to be filed in the appeal by the party in question;


NOTING that several Appeal Books have already been filed with the Registry;

CONSIDERING that the purpose of the Appeal Book is to facilitate reference to the documents to which each party will refer the Chamber during the hearing on the appeal;

NOW ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

1. The hearing in this matter shall take place on Wednesday 1 November 2000 and if necessary shall conclude on Thursday 2 November 2000;
2. Each party shall file a supplement to their Appeals Book within seven days of the date of this Order where the Appeals Books already filed do not include every document (including legal submissions) to which the party intends to refer the Chamber during the hearing.
