NOTING the Judgement and Sentence of Trial Chamber I dated 27 January 2000 whereby Alfred MUSEMA ("the Appellant") was convicted of one count of genocide and two counts of crimes against humanity and sentenced to a single sentence of life imprisonment;


NOTING the "Grounds of Appeal against Conviction and Sentence" filed by the Appellant on 1 March 2000;

NOTING the "Order (Hearing on Appeal)" dated 21 February 2001 which sets the date of the hearing on Monday, 28 May 2001;

HEREBY ORDER that the Appellant shall be granted two hours to present his oral submissions, the Prosecution two hours to respond to the Appellant's submissions and the Appellant a further half hour to reply, if he so wishes, at that hearing.
