WARRANT OF ARREST AND DETENTION

THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA (the "Tribunal)

SITTING AS Judge Navanethem Pillay, designated pursuant to Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules");

CONSIDERING that Siméon Nshamihigo is provisionally detained by the Tribunal, following an Order issued by Judge Mehmet Güney on 21 May 2001, pursuant to Rule 40 *bis* of the Rules;

CONSIDERING that the aforementioned Order expires on 24 June 2001;

CONSIDERING that the Indictment against Siméon Nshamihigo was confirmed on 23 June 2001;


CONSIDERING Articles 18(2), 19(2) and 28 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rules 40 and 54 to 59 *bis* of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS the Registrar to:

(i) **Arrest** Siméon Nshamihigo, a Rwandan citizen, born on 8 September 1960 in Gatare *commune*, Cyangugu *préfecture*, Rwanda, who is accused of having committed during 1994 in Rwanda the following crimes: Genocide or alternatively Complicity in Genocide, Crime against Humanity (extermination alternatively murder) and violations of Article 3 Common to the Geneva Conventions and Additional Protocol II;

(ii) **Serve** on Siméon Nshamihigo at the time of his arrest, a certified copy of this Warrant of Arrest accompanied by a copies of the Indictment and Confirmation Order, in accordance with Rule 47 (G) of the Rules and a statement of the rights of the Accused as set forth in Article 20 of the Statute and *mutatis mutandis* in Rules 42 and 43 of the Rules;



(iii) **Caution** Siméon Nshamihigo that any statement made by him shall be recorded and may be used as evidence against him;

(v) **Remand** Siméon Nshamihigo in custody in the Tribunal's Detention Facility.
