DECISION CONFIRMING THE INDICTMENT

THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA ("the Tribunal"),

SITTING AS Judge Erik Møse, designated by the President of the Tribunal pursuant to Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");

CONSIDERING the ex parte application made by the Prosecutor for the review and the confirmation of an indictment against **Protais Zigiranyirazo**, dated 18 July 2001;

HAVING HEARD the Prosecutor during a confirmation hearing held on 19 July 2001;

CONSIDERING that during the hearing the Tribunal requested the Prosecutor to effect a number of corrections to the indictment and that the Prosecutor complied;

CONSIDERING Articles 17 and 18 of the Statute and Rule 47 of the Rules;

BEING SATISFIED from the material tendered by the Prosecutor that there is sufficient evidence to provide reasonable grounds for believing that **Protais Zigiranyirazo** has committed crimes within the jurisdiction of the Tribunal, and is thereby convinced that a *prima facie* case has been established with respect to the two alternative counts as set out in the indictment;

HEREBY

CONFIRMS the indictment submitted by the Prosecutor against **Protais Zigiranyirazo** with respect to the two alternative counts of the indictment;

ORDERS, pursuant to Rule 70 of the Rules, that Explanatory Notes that have been made available to the Confirming Judge to facilitate the confirmation hearing, being internal working documents of the Prosecutor, are not subject to the disclosure provisions of Rule 66 and shall be returned to the Prosecutor.
