WARRANT OF ARREST AND ORDER FOR DETENTION

THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA (“the Tribunal”),

SITTING AS Judge Erik Møse, designated pursuant to Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”);

CONSIDERING Articles 18(2), 19(2) and 28 of the Statute of the Tribunal (“the Statute”) and Rules 55 to 61 of the Rules;

CONSIDERING the indictment submitted on 20 July 2001 by the Prosecutor against **Jean Mpambara**;

CONSIDERING the Tribunal’s Decision of 23 July 2001 confirming the said indictment;

CONSIDERING that **Jean Mpambara** is provisionally detained at the Tribunal’s Detention Facilities in Arusha on the basis of an order made by the Tribunal pursuant to Rule 40*bis* of the Rules on 21 June 2001;

HEREBY DIRECTS the Commanding Officer of the Tribunal’s Detention Facilities

(1) to arrest and to maintain in custody, on behalf of the Tribunal:

Jean Mpambara, born in 1954 in Rukara *commune*, Kibungo préfecture, Rwanda;

(2) Serve upon the Accused at the time of his arrest in a language that he understands a certified copy of this Warrant of Arrest accompanied by a copy of the aforementioned indictment, certified in accordance with Rule 47(G) of the Rules and a statement of the rights of the Accused as set forth in Article 20 of the Statute and, *mutatis mutandis*, in Rules 42 and 43 of the Rules. If the Accused is unable to understand either of the Tribunal’s official languages, the aforementioned documents shall be served on him in a language he understands, provided this language is known to the Registrar;

(3) Inform the Accused of his right to remain silent and to caution him that any statement he makes shall be recorded and may be used in evidence.
