SITTING as Trial Chamber I, composed of Judge Navanethem Pillay, pursuant to Rule 73(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;



BEING SEIZED OF the Prosecutor’s ex parte motion for the issuance of subpoenae to Prosecution witnesses and request for an order to be issued to the Republic of Rwanda, filed on 18 June 2002 (“the motion”);

CONSIDERING the Prosecution’s request of 30 August 2002 to withdraw the motion;

TAKING ACCOUNT of the fact that Prosecution witnesses were finally brought to Arusha to testify and that the Prosecution’s case is now closed;

DEEMS the motion withdrawn.
