### THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TIBUNAL FOR RWANDA ("the Tribunal"),

**SITTING** as Judge Navanethem Pillay designated by the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rule 73 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("the Rules");

**BEING SEIZED OF** the Defence motion for Return of Property and Sanctions for Violation of Court Order dated, 1 November 2002;

NOTING the Prosecution response to the Defence motion, filed on 8 November 2002, requests an extension of time to file a response to the Defence motion for reasons that a lengthy and detailed investigation of the passage of the Accused's material, seized from the place where they were taken from in Benin to Arusha, will be required. The Prosecution adds they will also have to make contact with former Staff members of the Tribunal who no longer reside in Arusha;

CONSIDERING the Order of 7 September 2000 in *The Prosecutor v Joseph Nzirorera Case No. ICTR-98-44-I* whereby both parties were requested to jointly view the unsealing of confiscated items;

**FURTHER CONSIDERING** that the Prosecutor was also directed by the Order of 7 September 2000, to return to the Defence, all documents seized during the search on the 5 of June 1998, which the Prosecutor does not intend to use as evidence against the Accused;

IN CONSIDERATION OF the written briefs of the parties;

#### HEREBY ORDERS,

THE RETURN by the Prosecutor to the Defence, of all items derived from the "Nzirorera Inventory of Seized Material Presented during Inspection from 5-8 August 2002" as listed in annexture A, which the Prosecutor does not intend to use as exhibits in the Trial, within thirty (30) days of receipt of this order;

**SERVICE** by the Prosecution upon the Accused, of copies of all documents, tapes, photos and other material seized from the Accused which are retained as evidence by the Prosecutor, within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order;

**DECLARES** that in light of the Decision rendered, the Prosecution's request for an order for extension of time is now **MOOT** and is **DISMISSED**.
