THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA ("the Tribunal");

SITTING as Trial Chamber I, composed of Judge Navanethem Pillay, presiding, Judge Erik Møse, and Judge Asoka de Zoysa Gunawardana ("the Chamber");

BEING SEIZED of an oral application made in open court on 21 January 2003 by Counsel for Ferdinand Nahimana for inspection of microfiche material ("the application");

NOTING the Prosecution's opposition to the application on the grounds that the microfiche material has already been furnished to the Defence in the form of a CD-ROM;

RECALLING the Chamber's "Decision On The Prosecutor's Ex Parte Application To Exclude Certain Documents From Defence Inspection Of Microfiche Material" of 25 October 2002 ("the Decision");

NOTING that the material ordered to be disclosed in the Decision has already been provided by the Prosecution to the Defence, and that the Defence merely seeks to have the same material provided to them in the form of a microfiche, rather than a CD-ROM;

NOTING that the Chamber expended considerable effort to assist the Defence in obtaining this material which it currently possesses;

NOTING that the Defence has not raised any new issues not previously dealt with in the Decision;

HEREBY DENIES the application.
