**SITTING** as Trial Chamber I, composed of Judge Navanethem Pillay, presiding, Judge Erik Møse and Judge Asoka de Zoysa Gunawardana;

**BEING SEIZED OF** a Defence ex parte motion, filed on 19 March 2003, to request the assistance of the Trial Chamber in obtaining evidence from the current head of UNICEF,

Kigali, Rwanda, pursuant to Article 28 (Cooperation and judicial assistance) of the Statute of the Tribunal("the Statute");
