**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide or Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for such Violations in the territory of neighbouring States between 1 January 1994 and 31 December 1994 (the "Appeals Chamber" and the "International Tribunal", respectively);

**BEING SEIZED** of the Notices of Appeal filed by Gérard Ntakirutimana and Elizaphan Ntakirutimana on 21 March 2003 and of the Prosecution's Amended Notice of Appeal filed on 31 July 2003 from Judgement and Sentence of Trial Chamber I in *The Prosecutor v. Elizaphan and Gérard Ntakirutimana*, Cases No. ICTR-96-10 & ICTR-96-17-T, (the "Appeals");

**NOTING** that Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal provides, *inter alia*, that "After the expiry of the time-limits for filing the briefs provided for in Rules 111, 112 and 113, the Appeals Chamber shall set the date for the hearing";

**CONSIDERING** that the filing of the briefs in the Appeals is complete;
