### THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA ("Tribunal"),

**SITTING** as Trial Chamber III composed of Judges Lloyd G. Williams, Q.C., presiding, Andrésia Vaz and Khalida Rachid Khan ("Chamber");

**BEING SEIZED** of the "Defendant Motion to Withdraw *Pro Se* Motion to Exclude Evidence or, in the Alternative, Motion for Extension of Time," filed on 24 February 2004 ("Motion"), seeking a withdrawal of the Motion to Exclude Evidence and for the Return Properties Seized dated 25 November 2003, without prejudice, or for an extension of time;

**CONSIDERING** the Prosecutor's Response, filed on 1 March 2004, which does not object to the withdrawal of the Motion of 25 November 2003, but objects to the alternative request for an extension of time, in view of the Chamber's Decision of 18 November 2003 instructing the replacement of Lead Counsel and reminding the Defence that the Decision cannot be construed as a ground for the Defence to request a delay in the commencement of the trial;<sup>1</sup>

**RECALLING** the Decision rendered by the Chamber on 27 January 2004 ordering that Lead Counsel shall file any additional submissions not later that 25 February 2004;<sup>2</sup>

**TAKING NOTE** of the argument raised by the Defence that the withdrawal does not constitute a waiver to the substantive rights highlighted in the *Pro Se* Motion to Exclude Evidence, and of the Prosecutor's non objection to such withdrawal;

#### THE CHAMBER HEREBY

**GRANTS** the Defence Motion to Withdraw *Pro Se* Motion to Exclude Evidence, and having thus decided dismisses the request for extension of time.
