SITTING as Trial Chamber II composed of Judge William H. Sekule, Presiding, Judge Arlette Ramaroson and Judge Solomy Balungi Bossa (the "Chamber");

CONSIDERING its "Decision on Nyiramasuhuko's Motion to Declare the Evidence of Witnesses FAS Inadmissible Against Her" (the "Decision"), issued on 16 April 2004;
