I, WOLFGANG SCHOMBURG, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States, between 1 January 1994 and 31 December 1994 ("Appeals Chamber" and "International Tribunal", respectively),

BEING SEISED OF the "Requête aux fins de Prorogation de Délai pour le Dépôt du Mémoire en Appel – Articles 111 et 116 du Règlement de Procédure et de Preuve", filed by Emmanuel Ndindabahizi ("Appellant") on 24 August 2004 ("Motion");

NOTING the "Order of the Presiding Judge Assigning Judges and Designating the Pre-Appeal Judge" of 24 August 2004;

NOTING that Trial Chamber I of the International Tribunal has issued the judgement against the Appellant in the original English version on 15 July 2004 ("Judgement"), and that the Appellant has filed his Notice of Appeal on 13 August 2004;

CONSIDERING that the Motion seeks an extension of time to file the Appellant's Brief within seventy-five days¹ following the receipt of the French translation of the Judgement, on the basis that the Appellant and his counsel are "francophones";

NOTING that the Office of the Prosecutor has informed the Appeals Chamber that it does not object to the Motion:

CONSIDERING that under Rule 116(A) of the Rules, the Appeals Chamber may grant a motion for an extension of time if good cause is shown;

CONSIDERING that Rule 116(B) of the Rules provides that "where the ability of the accused to make full answer and defence depends on the availability of a decision in an official language other than that in which it was originally issued, that circumstance shall be taken into account as a good cause under the present Rule";

CONSIDERING that, in light of Rule 116(B) of the Rules, good cause has been shown for granting an extension of time pursuant to Rule 116(A) of the Rules;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

HEREBY GRANT the Motion:

ORDER that Emmanuel Ndindabahizi may file his Appellant's Brief within seventy-five days of receipt of the French translation of the Judgement;

DIRECT the Registrar to ensure that the French translation of the Judgement is provided without undue delay and immediately forwarded to the Appellant; and

DIRECT the Registrar to inform the Appeals Chamber about the day on which the Appellant will have received the French translation of the Judgement.
