THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("International Tribunal");

NOTING the "Judgement and Sentence" rendered in this case by Trial Chamber II on 1 December 2003;

NOTING the "Amended Notice of Appeal" filed by Juvénal Kajelijeli ("Appellant") on 28 April 2004; the "Grounds of Appeal Against Convictions and Sentence and Appellant's Brief" filed by the Appellant on April 22, 2004; the "Response Brief" filed by the Prosecution on 1 June 2004; and the "Appellant's Brief-In-Reply" filed on 2 August 2004;

NOTING that Rule 65bis(A) and (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules") which allows "the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge" to convene a status conference, to organise exchanges between the parties so as to ensure expeditious trial proceedings;

NOTING the "Order Designating a Pre-Appeal Judge", issued on 10 December 2003, appointing me as Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

NOTING the Order Postponing the Hearing of the Appeal for this case filed on 7 December 2004 postponing the date of the hearing of the appeal on account of the inability of Defence Counsel to attend the hearing;

CONSIDERING that Juvénal Kajelijeli is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in Arusha, Tanzania, pending the hearing of his appeal;

CONSIDERING that the presence of Defence Counsel is not required;


PURSUANT to sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules and after consulting the parties;
