THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("International Tribunal");

NOTING the "Judgement and Sentence" rendered in this case by Trial Chamber II on 1 December 2003;

NOTING the "Amended Notice of Appeal" filed by Juvénal Kajelijeli ("Appellant") on 28 April 2004; the "Grounds of Appeal Against Convictions and Sentence and Appellant's Brief" filed by the Appellant on 22 April 2004; the "Response Brief" filed by the Prosecution on 1 June 2004; and the "Appellant's Brief-In-Reply" filed on 2 August 2004;

CONSIDERING that the filing of the briefs in this Appeal is complete and that no other motion is currently pending;

NOTING the "Scheduling Order" issued by the Appeals Chamber in this case on 16 November 2004 in which the appeal hearing was originally scheduled for Friday, 10 December 2004, in Arusha;

NOTING the "Order Postponing the Hearing of the Appeal" issued by the Appeals Chamber in this case on 7 December 2004 in which the 10 December 2004 appeal hearing was postponed to a date to be set down in a separate order because Defence Counsel informed the Appeals Chamber that he would not be able to attend due to a serious medical emergency concerning his spouse;

HEREBY ORDERS that the appeal hearing in this case shall take place on Monday, 7 March 2005, in Arusha;


