CONSIDERING Article 13(4) of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 72 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;


CONSIDERING the composition of the Appeals Chamber of the Tribunal as set out in Document IT/237, issued on 21 July 2005;
