THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA ("Tribunal"),

SITTING as Trial Chamber III, composed of Judge Dennis C. M. Byron, Presiding Judge, pursuant to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");

CONSIDERING "Prosecutor's Request for Leave to Amend an Indictment pursuant to Rules 73, 50 and 51 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence" ("Motion"), filed by the Prosecutor on 23 November 2005;

NOTING the Response thereto, filed by the Defence for Francois Karera ("Defence") on 29 November 2005;

CONSIDERING that the trial in the instant case is scheduled to start on 9 January 2006;

CONSIDERING that in his proposed Amended Indictment, the Prosecutor seeks to delete Bugesera region to replace it by the prefecture of Kigali-Rural;



CONSIDERING that the entirety of the proposed Amended Indictment is relating to the prefecture of Kigali-Rural and Kigali-Ville, notably to the communes of Kankenze and Nyarugenge;

CONSIDERING that to assess the said Motion, the Chamber needs to be in possession of all the relevant information;

THE CHAMBER ACCORDINGLY DIRECTS the Prosecutor:

- I- to clarify whether the prefecture of Kigali-Rural is another denomination of Bugesera region or whether it is a different location;
- II- to clarify whether the allegations of crimes perpetrated in Kigali-Rural and Kigali-Ville refer only to the communes of Kankenze and Nyarugenge;
- III- to file, no later than Thursday 8 December 2005, additional information relating to the above mentioned areas, to allow the Chamber to decide this matter.
