DESIGNATION OF TRIAL CHAMBER UNDER RULE 11BIS

THE PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA,

BEING SEIZED OF the "Prosecutor's Request for Referral of the Indictment to Another Court", filed on 12 December 2006;

RECALLING that the Amended Indictment against Michel Bagaragaza has been confirmed and that he is presently in the custody of the Tribunal;

OBSERVING that under Rule 11*bis* (A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, after an indictment against an accused has been confirmed, the President of the Tribunal may designate a Trial Chamber for the purpose of referring a case to the authorities of a State in whose territory the crime was committed, in which the accused was arrested, or having jurisdiction and being willing and adequately prepared to accept such a case;

NOTING the Prosecution's submission that the crimes alleged in the Indictment against Michel Bagaragaza may be prosecuted in The Netherlands;

CONSIDERING that Rules 19 (A) and 27 (C) confers on the President the responsibility of co-ordinating the work of Chambers and the composition and re-composition of Trial Chambers for the efficient judicial administration of the Tribunal;

HEREBY DESIGNATES Trial Chamber III, comprising Judge Khalida Rachid Khan, presiding; Sergei Alekseevich Egorov; and Judge Inès Weinberg de Roca to consider this request, in accordance with Rule 11*bis*.
