THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("Appeals Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively);

NOTING the appeals filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution")¹ and Aloys Simba ("Appellant")² against the "Judgement and Sentence" rendered in the case *Prosecutor v. Aloys Simba* by Trial Chamber I on 13 December 2005 ("Trial Judgement");

NOTING that on 4 May 2005, the Trial Chamber requested the Registry to issue a subpoena to potential defence witness BJK1 ("BJK1"), and requested the Rwandan authorities to take all appropriate measures to ensure the witness' protection and to provide any other assistance requested by the Registry to facilitate the witness' attendance at trial;³

NOTING that, despite these measures, BJK1 did not in the end testify at trial;

NOTING that, on appeal, the Appellant alleges that Rwandan authorities interfered with BJK1⁴ and failed to comply with the Trial Chamber's Decision of 4 May 2005;⁵

CONSIDERING that, for the purpose of deciding the merits of the appeals in this case, the Appeals Chamber needs to be informed of any steps taken by the Registry in order to secure the attendance at trial of BIK1;
