

On 24 July 2007, the Chamber held a Status Conference to prepare for the next session of the Defence case. Having considered the submissions made during the Status Conference, the Chamber:

- I. **ORDERS** the next trial session, which will be the last for the Defence case, to begin on 3 September 2007 and run until 5 October 2007;
- II. **ORDERS** the Defence to immediately disclose to the Prosecution the identifying information relating to all Defence witnesses as per the Chamber's Order of 18 July 2007;¹
- III. **ORDERS** the Defence to disclose to the Prosecutor in a timely manner the revised order of appearance of the remaining Defence witnesses;
- IV. **REMINDS** the Defence of its obligation to provide all necessary information to WVSS so as to enable that Section to make adequate arrangements to bring the witnesses to Arusha. In view of the commencement date of the next session, the information to WVSS should be provided immediately;
- V. **ORDERS** the Defence, in cooperation with WVSS, to always have a sufficient number of witnesses in Arusha, ready to testify, to avoid any further interruptions in the presentation of the Defence case.
