

1. The Defence case in the present trial closed on 7 November 2007. During the status conference held on 8 November 2007, the Chamber indicated that a scheduling order would follow depending on the timing of the proposed site visit and the availabilities in the judicial calendar.
2. The site visit is scheduled to take place from 14 to 18 April 2008.² The Chamber consulted with the Parties with respect to the filing dates of their closing briefs and they agreed to file their submissions during the week following the site visit.
3. The closing arguments are scheduled to be heard on 28-29 May 2008.


THE CHAMBER HEREBY

- I. **ORDERS** the Parties to file their closing briefs no later than 25 April 2008;
- II. **DECIDES** that the Parties will be heard for their closing arguments on 28 and 29 May 2008; and
- III. **GRANTS** to each Party four hours for the presentation of their closing arguments as follows, subject to adjustments as appropriate:
 - a) three hours will be allocated to each Party for the presentation of its oral arguments, the Prosecutor, followed by the Defence; and
 - b) one hour will be allocated to each Party for the Prosecutor's response and the Defence's Reply.
